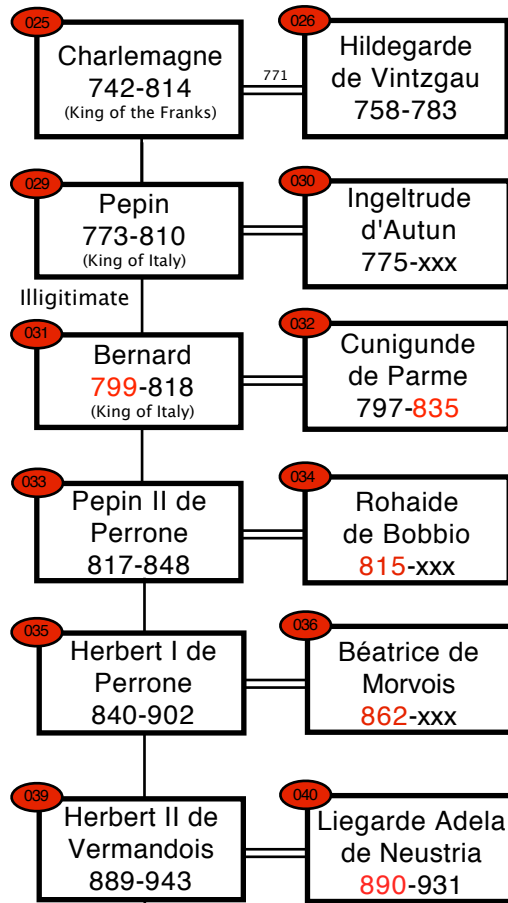


# Up To Charlemagne



This revision of the links to Charlemagne, and the resolution of the confusion concerning the descent of the Viscounts of Châteaudun, was possible after recent research by Christian Settipani (et alia.)

The discrepancies in dates and affiliation have now been resolved. Only the true affiliation of Foulquois de Mortagne remains to be resolved.

Foulquois was probably son of Hervé de Mortagne, but this family must have been related to the Viscounts of Châteaudun, otherwise the son of Melisende de Nogent and Foulquois could never become Viscount.

Geoffrey II thus was attributed the titles of Lord of Nogent-le-Rotrou, Count of Mortagne and Viscount of Châteaudun, a major step on the ladder to becoming Count of Perche.
