

### VECTOR INFORMATION

To help in locating individual Family Members in each diagram, members have a 4-digit number (FN), and are given a 3 character Vector Identification.

Vector Identification is found in each Family Member record of the De Nugent Data Base, and points to the location of the family member in a specific diagram.

Char 1 : Diagram Number (from 1 to 4).  
Char 2 : A letter (from A - Z) identifying the horizontal axis of the diagram.  
Char 3 : A number (from 1 - 9) identifying the vertical axis of the diagram.

Example : 486 locates James Nugent (FN=1761) within diagram 4.

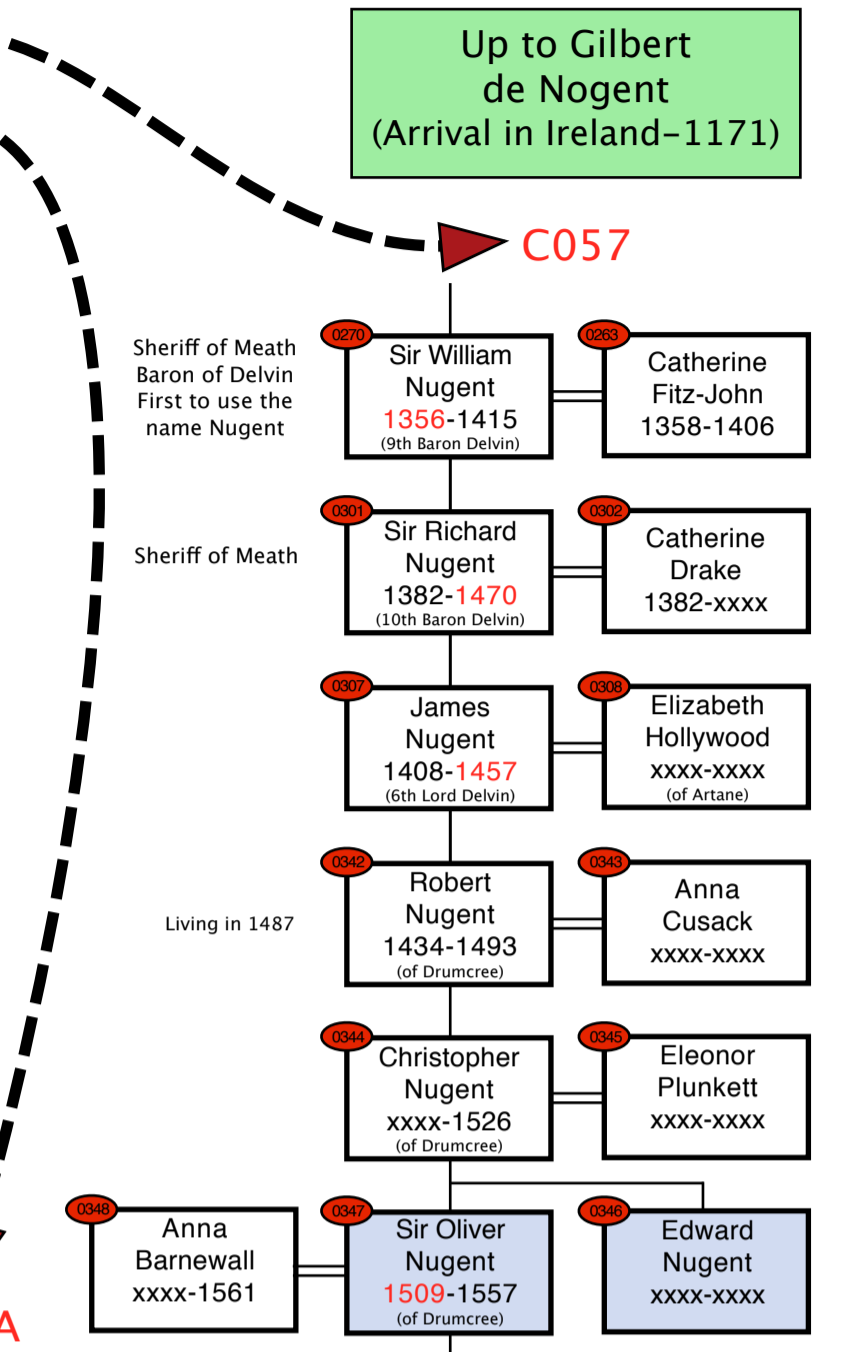

### The Corroborate Data Base


This "Cxxx" reference refers to a data file accessed by the "Corroborate" Data Base which provided the information used to build this diagram.
